INTRODUCTION

- ❖ It is essential that a CIMIC report is submitted to FHQ CIMIC weekly every Sunday before 1600hrs in order to adhere to FHQ Battle Rhythm.
- ❖ Force HQ CIMIC DOWNREP is a back brief to the Sectors' weekly report.



PURPOSE

- ❖ The purpose of reporting is to familiarise with and also to provide the military commander with means of examining the status of a specific area of operation or area of interest in order to identify critical shortfalls or capability gaps in the civil environment that may affect his/her mission, or of the opposing forces.
- ❖ Also to familiarise you with Reporting (Reports & Returns)
- ❖ To familiarise you with the Battle Rhythm of AMISOM



REPORTS AND RETURNS (R2)

What are they?

- ❖ a means of shaping (preparing and adjusting) and exploiting the information we find out in order to achieve our **Commander's Mission**

When do we use these reports?

- ❖ reports can be a regular routine (daily / weekly), when directed, or when we choose (should fit in with Comdr's 'battle rhythm')

REPORTING

FHQ to Sector CIMIC

- Weekly DOWNREP - Thursdays
- Adhoc: DDR reports, Refugee Return Note (Ref: AMISOM Example)

Sector CIMIC to FHQ -

- Weekly Sector CIMIC Report – By Sunday
 - Adhoc: CCTARC Report, Damage Report

EXAMPLE OF SECTOR CIMIC REPORT

Headings:

1. CRITICAL FACTORS

- Civilian factors that are affecting or might interfere with the military Ops. i.e; Humanitarian and other emergencies

EXAMPLES OF SECTOR CIMIC REPORTS

FUNCTIONAL SPECIFICS – WATER

- **Facilities; Serviceability; Supply; Availability; Location; Treatment; Pollution; Shortfalls; Civilian implications; and Military implications.**





EXAMPLES OF SECTOR CIMIC REPORTS

FUNCTIONAL SPECIFICS - POWER

- **Location; Facilities; Distribution network; Serviceability; Availability; Supply; Dependence etc and if shortfalls ,what implication it has to military and civilians.**



EXAMPLES OF SECTOR CIMIC REPORTS

FUNTIONAL SPECIFICS – HEALTH

- **Location; Facilities; Disease; Human resource; Medical waste; Hygiene; Shortfalls- what are the implications to both civilians and military.**



EXAMPLES OF SECTOR CIMIC REPORTS

FUNTIONAL SPECIFICS – SANITATION

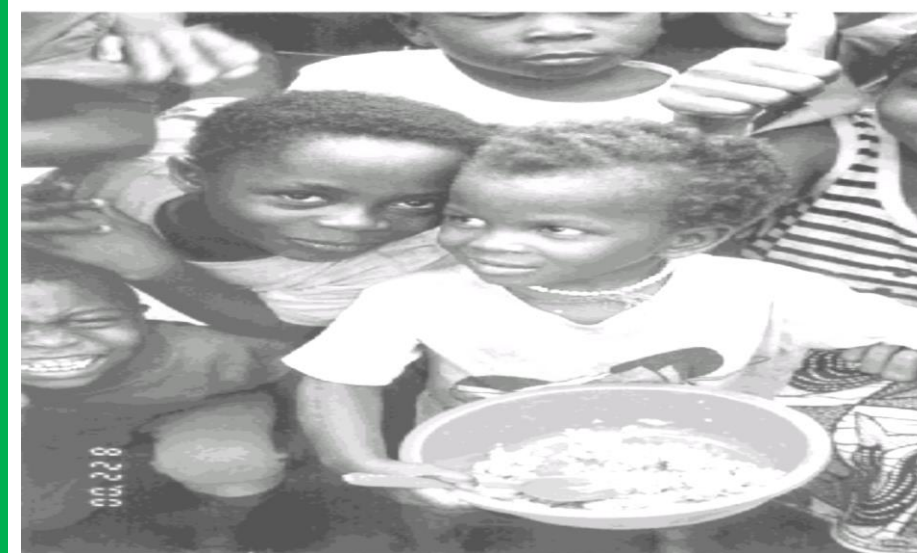
- Location; Facilities; Treatment;
Location; Shortfalls- what are the implications to both civilians and Mil.



EXAMPLES OF SECTOR CIMIC REPORTS

- **Availability; Supply; Distribution; and if Shortfalls what are the implications to Civilians and Military.**

EXAMPLES OF SECTOR CIMIC REPORTS

2. ASSESSMENT OF THE MILITARY SITUATION

- Analyse and assess the overall situation in line with the Mil Commander's CIMIC guidance.

3. DISPLACED PERSONS

- Consider population movements, status and circumstances.

4. HUMANITARIAN RELIEF

- Detail any requests for assistance with an assessment on how they will assist the Mil Mission



EXAMPLES OF SECTOR CIMIC REPORTS

5. CIVIL PROJECTS

- Report on projects that are planned, on-going or completed.

6. CONTACT / LIAISON WITH HROS

- Report on the activities of HROs and their impact on the Military Mission.

7. CONTACT / LIAISON WITH CIVIL AUTHORITIES AND ORGANISATIONS

- Report on the activities of these org and their impact on the Mil Mission



EXAMPLES OF SECTOR CIMIC REPORTS

8. CONTACT WITH CIVIL POPULATION

- Report news and views of the population and civilian casualties.

9. CIMIC RESOURCES

- Identify and assess any resource use and denial requirement.

10. FUTURE ACTIVITIES

- Forecast immediate 24hrs and interim 7days CIMIC activities in chronological order.



BATTLE RHYTHMS

Example: AMISOM Guidance note as contained in Annex c;

FORCE HQ BATTLE RHYTHM

Monday- Force Commander Partners Brief, Tuesday- Force Comd Brief preps, Wednesday – FC Brief, Thursday – Down Rep to Sectors, Friday – QIPS Weekly up dates to/from AMISOM QIP leads, Saturday – Humanitarian meetings with UNOCHA/ HLU, Sunday – Weekly Reports from Sectors are received.
